SALISBURY'S BUSKING CODE

Salisbury is a vibrant cathedral city and street buskers are a welcome part of that.

This is simple guidance for performers to help maintain a good relationship with those visiting, living and working in Salisbury.

BUSKERS SHOULD...

- 1. Play at a reasonable volume so not to distress shoppers and workers.
- 2. Ensure noise (music, voice and amplification) is not heard beyond 50 meters nor deemed a nuisance.
- 3. Abide by the Salisbury Buskers Code of Practice and cease performing immediately when requested to do so by Wiltshire Police, Salisbury BID representative or Council officer.

BUSKERS SHOULD NOT...

- 4. Perform at one location for more than two hours and should not return for two hours.
- 5. Obstruct the highway or fire exits and must ensure that their audiences do not either.
- 6. Perform within 50 meters of another busker or Big Issue vendor.
- 7. Cause offence or distress to businesses or the public.
- 8. Make use of street furniture without consent from Wiltshire Council.
- 9. Ask for money but can accept donations.
- 10. Offer items for sale without a Street Trading License.

Please note that whilst this is a voluntary code, failure to comply may result in more formal action being taken.

Breaches of the code make an offender liable to prosecution.
