Salisbury's street performance
code of practice





Please...

- Ensure all performers are over 14 years of age and that under 16's are accompanied by an adult.
- Ensure noise (music, voice and amplification) is not heard further than 50 metres from your location, nor deemed a nuisance.
- Abide by the Salisbury City Street Performance code of practice and cease performing immediately when requested to do so by Wiltshire Police, Salisbury BID representative or Council officer.
- Play at a reasonable volume so not to distress shoppers and workers.
- Ensure that drumming is only a minor part of the act.
- Ensure you have a permit from Wiltshire Council if performing to raise money for a charity.
- Ensure you have a street traders licence from Wiltshire Council which is displayed at all times in order to sell any merchandise.



Please do not...

- Perform at one location for more than two hours and ensure you do not return to the same location for a further two hours.
- Obstruct the highway or any fire exits and ensure that your audience does not either.
- Display any notices asking for payment or ask for money. Donations however can be accepted.
- Perform within 50 metres of another busker or Big Issue vendor.
- Cause offence or distress to businesses or the public.
- Make use of street furniture without consent from Wiltshire Council.
- Perform in the Old George Mall or the Maltings as this is not Salisbury City Council land

Please note that whilst this is a voluntary code, failure to comply may result in more formal action being taken. Breaches of the code make an offender liable to prosecution.
